

TRANSPORTATION

We will meet at Chets Creek at 9:00 a.m. the first day of camp & depart in school buses at 9:30. On the way to camp we will stop for a picnic lunch. Please pack a lunch for your child. On Friday, we will depart camp at 9:30 a.m., have a snack on the way at a rest stop, and arrive at Chets Creek at 3:00 p.m. A few leaders will drive their own cars to provide emergency transportation if necessary while at camp.

Kids are allowed to bring personal gaming devices for bus ride only.



FOOD

Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served in a buffet style cafeteria. There are many items to choose from during each meal. Camp food is kid friendly & void of most allergens. Each child must eat during meal times and drink at least 1 glass of water with each meal.
