

TRANSPORTATION

We will meet at Chets Creek at 9:00 a.m. the first day of (Hodges Campus) camp & depart in school buses at 9:30. On the way to camp we will stop for a picnic lunch. Please pack a lunch for your child. On Friday, we will depart camp at 9:30 a.m., have a snack on the way at a rest stop, and arrive at Chets Creek at 3:00 p.m. A few leaders will drive their own cars to provide emergency transportation if necessary while at camp.

Kids are allowed to bring personal gaming devices for bus ride only.



F O O D Breakfast, lunch, and dinner are served in a buffet style cafeteria. There are many items to choose from during each meal. Camp food is kid friendly & void of most allergens. Each child must eat during meal times and drink at least 1 glass of water with each meal.

Girls & Boys stay in separate dorm/hotel style accommodations. Each room is air conditioned & sleeps 4 kids. Towels and linens are not provided so sheets or sleeping bag are needed. ChetsKids leaders stay in separate rooms in the same hallway/suite.
